Catch a Car now at Geneva Airport

The car sharing provider Catch a Car is expanding its business area: from today, customers can also use the company's 100 cars for one-way trips to and from the Geneva Airport. To ensure smooth transfers, five parking spaces have been reserved at the airport.

The Mobility subsidiary Catch a Car has been operating in Geneva its free floating car sharing offer since November. 100 cars of the brand VW eco-move up! – powered by CO₂-neutral natural gas – are available for one-way trips throughout the entire metropolitan area of Geneva as well as in Carouge, Lancy, Vernier and Chêne-Bougeries. With immediate effect, Catch a Car is now also expanding its operational area to the Geneva Airport. "We want to offer our customers a flexible and versatile type of mobility," explains Adamo Bonorva, Managing Director of Catch a Car. "This means that I'm tremendously excited that we can now offer one-way trips to and from the Geneva Airport. We are convinced that the people in Geneva will appreciate and actively use this offer." As Catch a Car helps to reduce traffic, this will also improve the rather precarious lack of parking spaces at the airport.

Five permanent parking spaces

To have a basic supply of parking spaces, the company has rented five parking spaces in the P33 car park. "The cars can be parked or reserved there," says Bonorva. If by chance all parking spaces should be full, a short call to the customer service of Catch a Car is all that is needed to find an alternative solution in the car park.

Catch a Car AG is a subsidiary of the Mobility Cooperative. It operates Switzerland's first free floating car sharing offer in Geneva and Basel. Customers locate the cars online, drive from A to B, then leave them in a public parking space within a defined zone. Allianz and AMAG are on board as investors, with SwissEnergie and SBB as strategic partners.
